Regular Council Meeting

The Meeting was opened by Mayor, Steve Loucks.

The Pledge of Allegiance was led by David Summers.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read by the City Clerk. Motion to approve the minutes by Randy Dooley, seconded by Ron Davis. Motion Carried.

Theresa Stromeyer addressed that Council in regards to some concerns involving a Police Officer on March 22, 2017. Mrs. Stromeyer explained what happened. Discussion was then heard. This will be turned over to the Police Personnel Board to look into and come back to the Council with a report.

A building permit was presented for Darla Buckhannon at 204 Gray for a new garage in the amount of \$17,000.00 and a fence permit for Judith Marshall at 510 W. Yoakum. Contractors for both the fence permit and building permit do not have a merchant license. John Burgelin with Horner Schrifin addressed the council on options for the wastewater project and answered questions. He advised that the city has two options for moving forward: 1.) The City is satisfied with current Plans and Specs. and Horner Schifrin is not liable for errors and omissions of Schultz Surveying & Engineering Documents 2.) The City is unsatisfied with current Plans and Specs and wishes to redesign rehabilitation and/or complete inspection.

Fire Chief, Sam Glency advised that six fireman went to Fire training in Scott City. Mr. Glency advised that he will be assisting Travis Hendrix in blowing out culvert pipes. Mr. Glency advised of multiple rodents in the Fire Building and has called an exterminator. He advised that Ben Buckus will be attending summer fire school.
