In the absence of the City Administrator the Mayor advised that the Treatment system project is out for bids. The bid opening is scheduled for 10:00 AM, March 18, 2020.

The Mayor advised that S & W Cabinets would like a sewer main ran to their facility on N. Main. This would require a 500 ft. addition to the current main. The City Administrator attached a diagram. A ballpark cost to do this would be \$17,000.00 to 25,000.00. (The current main is around 4' deep so a pump would be required to reach the manhole at \$10,000.00 to \$14,000.00 and the line cost is around \$15.00 a foot.) Discussion was then heard. It was recommended that they be annexed into the City limits first. If they do not want to be annexed into the City limits then S & W would be required to pay for running the line and the lift station.

The Ordinance committee met on Thursday, March 5, 2020. The City administrator attached a copy of the recommended changes to Section 219 for the Council's review.

The City Administrator attached a copy of the proposed budget and a summary of new or requested items for the Council's review.

The City Administrator advised that the office has taken steps to increase routine cleaning of surfaces that are commonly in contact with the public. We have also placed hand sanitizer at the counter and at desks. The City Administrator included a draft pandemic flu leave policy.

The City Administrator attached a list of tasks completed by the public works department.
