Mr. Glency advised he is looking into finding the person who has the dish on the tower and notifying them that G & D Communications does not own the tower. Discussion was then heard.

Fire Chief, Sam Glency advised that he would like to move forward with the building behind the fire station. Discussion was then heard.

Fire Chief, Sam Glency advised that the 4<sup>th</sup> of July fireworks went very well and thanked the council and those that gave a donation for the electrical lighter.
