Regular Council Meeting

Due to Public health concerns relating to COVID-19 this meeting was conducted both at 222 W. Yoakum with physical distancing applied and electronically using zoom [https://us02web.zoom.us/ Meeting ID:871 8522 8428](https://us02web.zoom.us/MeetingID:87185228428), Passcode: 429538 as well as posted with the agenda.

The meeting was opened by Mayor, Steve Loucks.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read by the City Clerk. Motion to approve the minutes with the addition of the concrete work being done is at the Fire Station by Randy Dooley, seconded by Darla Buckhannon. Motion Carried.

Building Permits were presented for Laura Estes at 615 Hubbard for a new pool shed in the amount of \$3,000.00 and John Koch at 502 Elliott for a Shed in the amount of \$3,000.00. Motion to approve the building permits by Randy Dooley, seconded by Alan Cook. Motion Carried.

Police Department – Sergeant, Billy Sullivan advised that the Chief, Jim Chambers is still in the hospital and doing well.

Fire Department/Emergency Preparedness- Fire Chief, Sam Glency advised that the concrete at the Fire Station has been cut. Mr. Glency explained the digital radio equipment and advised that digital equipment for the Fire Department and Police Department would cost approximately \$50,000.00. Mr. Glency advised that they were not going to do in person fire prevention this year. Mr. Glency advised that he is doing the work on the Street Lights but is not done yet.

The City Clerk Presented the following bills for approval: Rhodes 101-Park-\$159.96, Police Department-\$558.69, and Public Works-\$493.22, Horner Shifrin-\$312.81, Waste Connections-\$19,047.40 and A T & T in the amount of \$492.56. The City Administrator advised that Waste Connections is doing better. Linda Jones was present to answer questions.

The City Administrator advised that the Ordinance Committee met on September 30th. He attached a copy of their recommendations for the nuisance ordinance for inoperable vehicles, parking of unlicensed vehicles on private property and driveways. The Committee recommended No trees or shrubbery shall be planted in the city right of way.

The City Administrator advised that he received a grant from the County in the amount of \$5,425.00 for disinfectant spray and body temperature detection.

The City Administrator advised that the City is in violation with DNR for effluent levels. The City Administrator advised he sent a letter to the DNR in regards to the effluent level and the steps we are taking to correct it.

The Mayor advised that Whitakers had agreed to pay for paving in the alley behind their business but no one else has agreed to this at this time.

Randy Dooley advised that he made contact with Dustin Boatwright with Little River drainage to see what if anything can be done with the storm water.
