The meeting was opened by the Mayor, Steve Loucks.

Pledge of Allegiance was led by Eric Seyer.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read by City Clerk. A motion to approve the minutes made by Eric Seyer, seconded by Ron Davis. All in favor. Motion Carried.

Chief Sullivan reported on the nuisance violations to the council. Out of 97 written warnings there were 9 citations.

Fire Chief Glency updated council on the repairs done on the fire house. Discussion was heard.

The Judges report for July was presented. Motion to approve the Judges report made by Eric Seyer, seconded by Mark Perkins. All in favor. Motion carried.

The City Administrator told council that Sean Salvo passed his certification test for Wastewater C certification from Missouri Department of Natural Resources. This is the operator certification needed to operate our wastewater treatment system and comply with our operation permit. Lee proposed a \$1.00 an hour pay increase for Sean Salvo. Motion to approve pay increase made by Ron Davis, seconded by Darla Britain. All in Favor. Motion carried.

The City Administrator Lee Horton presented a Sewer Treatment update; presented the New Work Order System in progress; update on the tire pickup project and informed council on AJ's building on Main St. which will be inspected by Brownsfield on an unknown date. Discussion was heard.

The City Administrator presented the request from the park board to share the cost of renovating the ball field. The total estimate from Turf Renovations is \$9000. The cost will be split three ways with \$3000 paid by the High School, \$3000 by the youth league and \$3000 from the park board. Motion to approve the ball field renovation made by Eric Seyer, seconded by Darla Britain. Council polled as follows;
