

Regular Council Meeting

The meeting was opened by the Mayor, Steve Loucks.

Pledge of Allegiance was led by Eric Seyer.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read by City Clerk. Motion to approve the minutes made by Danny Finley, seconded by Darla Britain. All in favor. Motion Carried.
