Regular Council Meeting

The meeting was opened by the Mayor, Steve Loucks.

Pledge of Allegiance was led by Eric Seyer.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read by the Assistant City Clerk. A motion made to approve the minutes by Steve Milz, seconded by Ryan Pobst. All in favor. Motion Carried.

No building permits were presented.

Police Chief Sullivan was present but had nothing for the Council.

Fire Chief Glency was not present.

The Court Report for May 2024 was presented. Motion made to approve the Court Report by Eric Seyer, seconded by Andy Sadler. All in favor. Motion carried.

Richard Britain proposed two ordinance change recommendations to the Council. The first, to change 210.285 to allow air gun, bows, etc. for adults/parents and guardians instructing children in gun/projectile safety. The second, an ordinance that will motivate residents to bring in their trash totes to keep them from blowing into the streets and becoming a safety issue. Discussion was heard. Mayor Loucks stated these recommendations would be referred to the Ordinance Committee.

Steve Milz proposed adding new stop signs in the following areas, to create 4-way stops, due to the high activity of children in these areas: 2nd and Frates, 2nd and Elliott, 3rd and Gray, 4th and Gray, 5th and Davidson Circle. Discussion was heard. Mayor Loucks discussed with Police Chief Sullivan about a survey/study for traffic and safety to be completed and brought to the next Council meeting.

City Administrator, Lee Horton presented the Council with a proposal to trade in the 2019 310SL Backhoe, in which the current lease will expire in September. A quote from John Deere was presented for a 2024 320 P-Tier Backhoe Loader with a 60 month warranty. Discussion was heard. The Council requested more information to be brought to the next council meeting.

City Administrator presented the Council with a proposal to use ARPA funds for the \$5200.00 repair of the 2003 Ford F550 lift truck, which is currently in the shop for brake and other problems. Discussion was heard. Motion made to use ARPA funds for the repairs made by Eric Seyer, seconded by Ron Davis. Council polled as follows:
