The City Administrator informed the Council there will be a public hearing on the tax rate levy at the August 19th council meeting.

The City Administrator informed the Council that the Library Board had recommended a pay increase for Tina Horton from \$15.00/hr to \$16.00/hr. The increase should be retroactive to January 1, 2024.
