

Regular Council Meeting

This meeting was conducted at both 222 W. Yoakum and electronically using www.zoom.us. Meeting ID: 861 8551 0253 and Passcode: 809256.

Council Members: Tony Enderle, Ron Davis, Andy Sadler, Mark Perkins, Steve Milz, Danny Finley, Tara Golightly were present and Eric Seyer via Zoom.

The meeting was opened by the Mayor, Steve Loucks.

The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Tara Golightly.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read by the City Clerk. A motion made to approve the minutes by Andy Sadler and seconded by Ron Davis. All in favor. Motion Carried.

A Building permit was presented for Robert Mayfield at 423 Helen for a new carport. A motion was made to approve the building permit by Steve Milz, seconded by Danny Finley. All in favor. Motion Carried.

Police Chief Sullivan supplied the Council with the Nuisance Warnings/Citations Report for June 2025 and information on the Flock camera system. He would like to present this to the Council at the July 21st meeting. Billy also wants to introduce this system to the community and local businesses to gauge the public response and ask for donations to cover the expense. Discussion was heard.

Fire Chief Glency was present but had nothing for the Council.

Andy Sadler updated the Council for the Park Department.

The Park Board is having trouble getting members and has decided to drop to 7 members, 3+3+ the President as tie breaker. They intend to have a color Run for donations to raise money and have fun. The Board wants to do away with rental fees for the fields but the pavilions will still have charges. All travel ball teams must have insurance filed with the City. The Board would like all teams to have schedule access. They intend to get a portable fence at Frisco North for Little League. Andy also said that Rusty has the poles ready and they are still looking for someone to set them. Discussion was heard.

The City Clerk presented the following bills: MFA Oil in the amount of \$2,474.54 and Republic Services in the amount of \$16,591.44. Discussion was heard. A Motion to pay the bills was made by Andy Sadler, seconded by Ron Davis. Council polled as follows:

The Collectors Report for June 2025 was presented. A Motion to approve the Collectors Report was made by Danny Finley, seconded by Steve Milz. All in favor. Motion carried.

The City Administrator, Lee Horton presented the Council with a map showing the properties that are proposed for annexation and the suggested new city limits on the northeast side of town. There is also an article regarding annexation procedures from the Missouri Municipal League, a letter to the landowners and a proposed petition to be sent out if the Council approves. Discussion was heard. It was decided that Lee will send out the letters.

The City Administrator supplied the Council with a copy of the original deed with conditions for Harmon Field, showing the clause regarding charging a fee for use for betterment of the field, on Page 2. The field rental policy and an article on Park Boards in Missouri were included. Lee stated that our Park Board is administrative; the City Council only oversees expenditures since over half our park budget is from the general fund. Discussion was heard.

Lee also informed the Council that the mosquito fogger is 12 years old and in rough shape, it should make it through this season but he will be getting bids on replacing it. Discussion was heard.

Andy Sadler asked if anything could be done about the ditches, culverts and standing water issues for properties around the Family Dollar. Discussion was heard.

The meeting was adjourned.
