

Regular Council Meeting

This meeting was conducted at both 222 W. Yoakum and electronically using www.zoom.us. Meeting ID: 856 0361 3918 and Passcode: 169922.

Council Members: Tony Enderle, Ron Davis, Andy Sadler, Mark Perkins, Steve Milz, Danny Finley, Tara Golightly, and Eric Seyer were present.

The meeting was opened by the Mayor, Steve Loucks.

The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Eric Seyer.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read by the City Clerk. A motion was made to approve the minutes by Steve Milz and seconded by Danny Finley. Discussion was heard. All present in favor. Motion Carried.

Building permits were presented for Zachary Dannemueller at 427 Wright for a covered patio and Mark Lueder at 110 Dame for an addition to an existing building. Discussion was heard. Police Chief Sullivan introduced Kristen MacLeod from FLOCK Safety and Bryan Tambeau, a FLOCK Sales Executive via Zoom for their Web based presentation on the FLOCK Camera System. This presentation described the collaborative policing technology, functions, capabilities and cost. Kristen and Bryan also answered questions from the Council. Discussion was heard.

Andy Sadler updated the Council for the Park Department. The Park Board would like to put a 36 inch door or a roll-up door on the current shed and re-allocate the previously approved funds to refurbishing the dug outs at Middle Field. The work would be completed by Jeremy Lynn and they are hoping to split the estimated \$8,600.00 cost between the Youth League, the Chaffee High School, the Park Department and the Booster Club all paying around \$2,150.00 each.
