

Regular Council Meeting

This meeting was conducted at both 222 W. Yoakum and electronically using www.zoom.us. Meeting ID: 823 8823 1514 and Passcode: 133703.

Council Members: Tony Enderle, Ron Davis, Andy Sadler, Mark Perkins, Steve Milz, Danny Finley, Tara Golightly, and Eric Seyer were present.

The meeting was opened by the Mayor, Steve Loucks.

The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Eric Seyer.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read by the Assistant City Clerk. A motion made to approve the minutes by Ron Davis and seconded by Eric Seyer. All present in favor. Motion Carried.

Police Chief Sullivan announced that the first FLOCK camera was in place on Route M and training is underway for his department. He also announced there are more donations still inbound for the FLOCK system. He requested the council allow for the creation of a new account for Law Enforcement Training and donations specifically for the FLOCK system. Motion made by Eric Seyer to create a new account specifically for FLOCK system and seconded by Tara Golightly. All present in favor. Motion Carried. Eric Seyer also requested the Police Chief Sullivan have officers present at the corner of 3rd St and Heeb St in the mornings to discourage drivers ignoring stop signs. Discussion was heard.

Fire Chief Glency presented the council with a quote and parts list from Sentinel regarding the repair of a pump on the city's backup fire truck. With the lead time for parts, it was his recommendation that the fire truck be sent in for repairs at the earliest possible time, likely in October. The repairs were estimated to be approximately \$15,000. Fire Chief Glency weighed this against the cost of replacing this truck with a used one for a minimum of \$150,000 or with a new one for a minimum of \$800,000. Motion made by Eric Seyer to attempt the repairs on the fire truck. Seconded by Mark Perkins. Council polled as follows:

Fire Chief Glency also informed the Council that members of the Fire Department were beginning a Fire Fighters Association to assist with nonprofit fundraising to donate to the Fire Department.

Andy Sadler updated the Council for the Park Department's plans for the dugouts and the necessity of pool repairs before next swimming pool season. He also reiterated the need for the poles to be set up at Frisco field. Discussion was heard. Andy suggested that he would have more information on these topics at the next meeting.

The Judges Report was presented. Motion to approve the Judges Report made by Eric Seyer. Seconded by Danny Finley. All present in favor. Motion carried.

The Assistant City Clerk presented the following bills: MFA Oil in the amount of \$2,223.76 and Republic Services in the amount of \$16,679.04. A Motion to pay the bills was made by Steve Milz, seconded by Danny Finley. Council polled as follows:

The Collectors Report for August 2025 was presented. A Motion to approve the Collectors Report was made by Eric Seyer, seconded by Steve Milz . All present in favor. Motion carried.

The City Administrator, Lee Horton reminded the Council of important dates that were approaching. These dates were October 3rd and 4th, for the City Wide Yard Sale, and October 21st and 23rd for the free city wide cleanup. Discussion was heard.

The City Attorney was present and informed the Council that the municipal court for September had been postponed for one month.

Eric Seyer suggested looking into patching a section of Davidson Street between Main Street and 2nd Street. He also suggested that the city provide new chairs for City Hall employees. Discussion was heard.

Tara Golightly informed the Council that she had received comments about the state of a house on the corner of 2nd Street and Parker. Police Chief Sullivan informed the Council that he had started with a condemned notice the previous month. Discussion was heard.

Mark Perkins requested that the City Administrator research ordinances both about the required upkeep of rental properties and about required licensure for pouring concrete within city limits. Discussion was heard.

Steve Milz requested that the city employees go through the City Administrator with things that could result in issues within the city. He also requested to be informed about bulk water usage. Discussion was heard.
