

Regular Council Meeting

This meeting was conducted at both 222 W. Yoakum and electronically using www.zoom.us. Meeting ID: 881 2819 3133 and Passcode: 469458.

Council Members: Tony Enderle, Ron Davis, Andy Sadler, Steve Milz and Tara Golightly were present. Mark Perkins and Danny Finley were absent.

The meeting was opened by the Mayor Pro-Tem, Eric Seyer.

The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Tara Golightly.

The minutes of the previous meeting were presented to the council. A motion made to approve the minutes by Andy Sadler and seconded by Ron Davis. All present in favor. Motion Carried.

Building and fence permits were presented for; Michael Rhodes Jr. for a new house at 405 Cook, Lukis Frey for an 8x12 shed at 421 Cook, Kimberly Gustufson for a chainlink fence at 205 W. Davidson, Mark Lueder for a fence at 110 Dame and Bradyn Swinford for a fence at 114 Heeb. Discussion was heard. A motion was made to approve the building and fence permits for 405 Cook, 205 W. Davidson and 110 Dame by Andy Sadler, seconded by Tony Enderle. All present in favor. Motion Carried.

A motion was made to table approval for the building and fence permits for 421 Cook for needed signature and 114 Heeb for clarification by Andy Sadler, seconded by Tony Enderle. All present in favor. Motion Carried.

Police Chief Sullivan passed out a resolution to be gone over and signed by the Council. Billy discussed the Blue Shield resolution, which if qualified for the program the City would be eligible to receive up to a \$50,000.00 grant. Discussion was heard. A motion to pass the resolution was made by Steve Milz and seconded by Tony Enderle. All present in favor. Motion Carried. The resolution was initialed by the present Council members.

Fire Chief Glency updated the Council on the status of the Emergency Preparedness supplies. He also supplied a flyer describing the cots he was able to purchase from the Missouri Federal Surplus Property System for a steep discount. 60 cots were purchased for \$1,800.00, a discount of \$5,403.00, the invoice was included in the monthly bills. Discussion was heard.

Fire Chief Glency and Assistant Chief Cody Johnson supplied information and a services agreement from Fire Recovery USA, a fire billing solutions company. An Ordinance establishing and implementing a program to charge mitigation rates for the deployment of emergency and non-emergency services by the fire department for services provided/rendered by/for the City of Chaffee Fire Department was also supplied to be gone over by the Council. Discussion was heard. A motion to have the City Attorney review the wording of the Ordinance was made by Steve Milz, seconded by Andy Sadler. Council polled as follows:

There is a special meeting scheduled for the 18th to discuss completing projects.
