

Regular Council Meeting

This meeting was conducted at both 222 W. Yoakum and broadcasted on Face Book Live.

The meeting was opened by the Mayor, Samuel Glency.

The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Eric Seyer.

The minutes of the previous meeting were presented to the Council. A motion made to approve the minutes by Andy Sadler and seconded by Mark Perkins. All in favor. Motion Carried.

Andy Sadler stated that the ditch at the 5th block of Yoakum needs attention. Lee said he has spoken with the DOT about it. Discussion was heard.

Police Chief Sullivan was present but had nothing for the Council.

Assistant Fire Chief Johnson told the Council that Premier Communications is scheduled Wednesday for the install of a radio. Discussion was heard.

Andy Sadler stated that the pool looks great. The Mayor asked for names of those involved with the work so they may be commended. Discussion was heard.

Mark Perkins asked about the time keeping system and the work order system. The City administrator stated the time keeping system is live but paper print outs are still being used and the work order system kicked off testing last week and they are running the essential program not the asset program.
